HAND-BUILT CERAMICS *with Lia Klugman*

Date & Time: Monday from 10am - 1pm for 9 weeks

As well as teaching the essential ceramic skills of hand-building homewares and sculptural pieces and wheel work, Lia specializes in decoration techniques – painting with underglaze colours, using coloured slips (sgraffito, marbling etc), using coloured clay inlays, oxides and 3rd firing lustres. Lia inspires students to bring out their best artistic talent.

TRANSPORT: Bus No. 380, 381 or 382 from Bondi Junction. Please note there is no parking on the school grounds, except for disabled drivers.

MATERIALS: Requirements for the first lesson:

- Sketchbook and pencil
- Plastic bags (shopping type to cover work & store clay)
- Pointed knife – short bladed, not serrated
- Small foam sponge and a larger one for cleaning
- Disposable gloves
- Safety Goggles
- Dust Mask

Vicki will discuss tools and materials with students during the first class. For a complete list see below.

Glazes are included in the course fee.

Clay can be purchased in class for \$4 per kilo or \$25/bag. Firing fees are \$4 per kilo firing. It usually takes 2 firings to bring a pot to the finished stage.

TOOL LIST:

- Rolling pin (the best is a piece of PVC pipe – 50cm long)
- A wooden modelling tool (one end square, one end round)
- A few brushes (small, medium, large)
- A piece of cloth backed vinyl (approx 50cm x 60cm)
- Cutting wire (30cm of strong fishing line attached to 2 corks)
- A metal kidney
- A wooden kidney
- A rubber kidney

WHEELWORK:

- Wooden modelling tool
- Turning tool
- Wooden kidney
- Pottery needle (wooden or metal mounted)
- Pointed knife – long bladed, not serrated
- Sponge
