

Conditions of Entry for the 9x5 prize

1. Eligibility

The 9x5 Prize is open to all artists 16 years and over.

2. Prizes.

The 9x5 First Prize: \$1,000. The 9x5 Second Prize: \$500

3: A Prize for Painting

Entries in the 9x5 Prize may be paintings in any medium, including oil, acrylic or watercolour. The theme is open.

Entries close: 12 midday Tuesday 2nd October 2018

4. Artwork Specifications

Works must be painted on the 9" x 5" plyboard supplied by the WWAS office. No other material will be accepted. Wet paintings will not be accepted and works must be unframed.

5. How to Enter

Entry to the 9 x 5 landscape Prize is a 2 step Process.

1. **Registration:** Fill in the registration form and pay \$30 per entry. Select to collect your board/s or have them sent to you. You will receive a confirmation email with instructions and a link to submit an image of your artwork. Registrations made after Sunday 23 September require boards to be collected only.
2. **Submission:** Click on the link provided to you and upload an image of your artwork/s.

Entries open: Wednesday 1st August 2018 and close at 12.00 midday on Tuesday 2nd October 2018
Finalists in the 9x5 exhibition are selected by the judges from digital images of each artwork entered.

6. Image format and submission

Each image must be submitted

- JPEG format, 300dpi and less than 2MB in file size

Each image must be clearly labelled with the artist's name and title of artwork.

7. Entry Fee

A fee of \$30 per entry (including GST) per entry.

If you cannot pick up 9 x 5 boards from the School, an extra postage charge of \$8 will apply.

8. Number of Entries

A maximum of three (3) entries per artist.

9. Judges

Two individual judges, independent of WWAS, will select the successful entrants on Monday 13th November.

10. Process of Selection

The Judges will select the finalists for the exhibition from digital images of each artwork entered. The winner will be judged from the finalists. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence or dispute will be entered into by the judges.

11. Announcement of finalists

Works which have been selected for exhibition will be announced online at www.wwas.org.au/9x5 prize from Tuesday 20th November 2018. All entrants will receive an email.

12. Delivery of Finalists for Exhibition

Selected finalists will be given instructions about delivery of works and submission of artist statement, details and price of artwork, if for sale.

Works that have been selected to be hung in the exhibition must be delivered to Waverley Woollahra Art School no later than 12.00 midday Thursday 29th November 2018.

13. Sale of Artworks and commission

At the artist's discretion, selected entries can be offered for sale at the exhibition. A 30% commission applies to all artworks sold, with proceeds returned to the Waverley Woollahra Art School. The sale price indicated on the entry form must remain fixed throughout the exhibition and should include the commission, GST (if applicable) and any other commercial gallery or agents' fees. If an entry is not for sale, please mark it clearly with NFS on the back of the artwork and on the entry form. Sales can be made from Thursday 7th December at the prize giving and for the duration of the exhibition.

14. Reproduction of Images

Waverley Woollahra Art School reserves the right to use the digital images of artworks entered in the 9x5 Prize, and photographs of artworks in the exhibition, for the purposes of publicity, documentation and cataloguing in paper, digital and electronic format.

15. Privacy

Personal information collected will only be used for the purposes of the 9x5 Prize or WWAS promotion and will be held by the administration staff of Waverley Woollahra Art School.

16. Ownership

Entries must not be the property of a third party. If an artwork is being entered by a commercial gallery or agent, the artist must give their permission.

17. Exhibition Period

Entries selected for exhibition must be displayed for the entire exhibition period from 10.00 am to 4.00 pm Thursday 13th December – Sunday 16th December 2018.

Works must be collected no later than 12.00 midday on Wednesday 19th December. Works collected late will incur a late fee of \$5 per day.

18. Insurance

Artists are responsible for insuring their artworks against theft and damage during transit and throughout the exhibition. Waverley Woollahra Art School will take all reasonable care, but will not be responsible or liable for any loss or damage.
