

**Due to Covid 19 Restrictions, finalists in the 2020 9x5 Landscape Prize may be shown as a virtual exhibition online, rather than being hung at the WWAS Annual Students' End of Year Show as in previous years. A decision on the format of this year's exhibition will be made and announced when finalists are announced in November 2020.**

## **Conditions of Entry for the 9x5 Landscape Prize 2020**

### **1. Eligibility**

The 9x5 Landscape Prize is open to all artists 16 years and over. WWAS staff, board members and tutors are not eligible to enter.

### **2. 9x5 Landscape Prizes.**

First Prize: \$1,000.

Second Prize: \$500, sponsored by Waverley Council.

Most Highly Commended: Art materials provided by Derivan to the value of \$200.

### **3: A Prize for Painting**

Entries in the 9x5 Landscape Prize may be paintings in any medium, including oil, acrylic or watercolour. The theme is open.

**Entries open: 9.00am Monday 10<sup>th</sup> August 2020**

**Entries close: Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> October 2020**

### **4. Artwork Specifications**

Works must be painted on the 9" x 5" plywood boards supplied by the WWAS office.

No other material will be accepted. Wet paintings will not be accepted and works must be unframed.

### **5. How to Enter**

Entering the 9x5 Landscape Prize is a two-step process:

**Registration:** Register by completing the online form at [wwas.org.au/9-x-5-landscape-prize/](http://wwas.org.au/9-x-5-landscape-prize/)

You will receive a code via email once you have registered. You will need this code to upload images of your artwork. You need to register to receive your official 9x5 board\*

**Submission:** Submit a digital image of each artwork before midday, 1<sup>st</sup> October via your online registration. Upload one image of each entry. To access your registration use the link sent to you when you register.

\*Boards can be collected from the WWAS office at 138 Bondi Road, Bondi, NSW or sent to you via mail.

Due to Covid-19 restrictions the office at WWAS is not open every day. Boards can be collected from the office on **Mondays and Tuesdays from 9.00am to 4.00pm**. If you are unable to pick up your board(s) during this time, please ring the office on 9387 2461 to arrange a convenient time when the office will be attended or have the board(s) posted to you.

If opting for mail delivery of your board/s please allow sufficient time to receive the official 9x5 board and create your artwork before the closing date. Boards will not be sent via mail after Friday 21<sup>st</sup> September.

**Entries open Monday 10<sup>th</sup> August 2020 and close Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> October 2020**

Finalists in the 9x5 Landscape Prize are selected by the judges from digital images of each artwork entered.

### **6. Image format and submission**

Each image must be submitted as a JPEG file, 300dpi and less than 2mb in file size.

Each image must be clearly labelled with the artist's name and title of artwork.

## **7. Entry Fee**

**\$35 per entry** (including GST)

If you cannot pick up 9 x 5 boards from the School, an extra postage charge of \$9 will apply.

## **8. Number of Entries**

**A maximum of three (3) entries per artist.** Each entry must be on a separate entry form.

## **9. Judges**

The judges for the 2020 9x5 Landscape Prize are Peter Griffen and Alison Clark.

## **10. Process of Selection**

The Judges will select the finalists for the exhibition from digital images of each artwork entered. The winner will then be judged from the finalists selected. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence or dispute will be entered into by the judges.

## **11. Announcement of finalists**

## **12. Delivery of Finalists for Exhibition**

If the selected finalists' artworks are to be hung at the WWAS Students' End of Year Exhibition, original artworks must be delivered to Waverley Woollahra Art School no later than 12.00 midday **Friday 4th December 2019.**

If you wish your artwork to be returned to you by mail at the end of the exhibition, please include a stamped, addressed envelope with your original artwork.

## **13. Sale of Artworks and commission**

At the artist's discretion, selected entries can be offered for sale. A 30% commission applies to all artworks sold, with proceeds returned to the Waverley Woollahra Art School. The sale price indicated on the entry form must remain fixed throughout the exhibition and should include the commission, GST (if applicable) and any other commercial gallery or agents' fees. If an entry is not for sale, please mark it clearly with NFS on the back of the artwork and on the entry form.

## **14. Reproduction of Images**

Waverley Woollahra Art School reserves the right to use the digital images of artworks entered in the 9x5 Landscape Prize, and photographs of artworks in the exhibition, for the purposes of publicity, documentation and cataloguing in paper, digital and electronic format.

## **15. Privacy**

Personal information collected will only be used for the purposes of the 9x5 Landscape Prize or WWAS promotion and will be held by the administration staff of Waverley Woollahra Art School.

## **16. Ownership**

Entries must not be the property of a third party. If an artwork is being entered by a commercial gallery or agent, the artist must give their permission.

## **17. Exhibition Period**

If the original artworks are to be exhibited, finalists' entries must be displayed for the entire exhibition period from 10.00 am to 4.00 pm **Thursday 12th December – Sunday 13th December 2020.**

Works must be collected no later than 12.00 midday on **Wednesday 16th December.**

Works collected late will incur a late fee of \$5 per day.

## **18. Insurance**

Artists are responsible for insuring their artworks against theft and damage during transit and throughout the exhibition. Waverley Woollahra Art School will take all reasonable care, but will not be responsible or liable for any loss or damage.
